Casey FitzRandolph and Suzy Favor Hamilton will visit students at the Kickapoo Area Schools on Tuesday. Their visit is part of a program called "Movin' and Munchin'" run by the Department of Public Instruction and sponsored by the WEA Trust.

Both FitzRandolph and Favor Hamilton serve as honorary chairpersons of the Movin' and Munchin' program.
